Relatively simple canyon although not for beginners in this sport, a first rappel of 42m, several areas of handrails and a somewhat exposed return are its difficulties.

Lush, leafy environment and after rains with multiple pools, a delightful environment.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

Getting to the Anaga area on the TF12 road

At p.k. 23.5 we have the detour by the TF143 towards Los Batanes, at the kilometer we turn right to continue to Los Batanes. Then we will see the detour to Bejia on the left, we will go down here until the end.

Approach: (machine translated)

There is no better explanation than Naturexperiences:

"At the end of the asphalt road, a dirt road begins, we leave behind a house on the right and when we reach a crossroads, on the left, we turn off. We go down a few meters towards the riverbed and when we pass a danger sign, we turn off again to the right.

We climb a little and continue along a path that leads to a narrow pass, where we find a pipe. We go down to the small pools that are at the bottom, taking care with the pipe and walk a little to the first and largest rappel of this descent. This rappel is 41 meters."

Tour: (machine translated)

After the first 40m rappel, we leave to the left to a path that allows us to take the Bejía channel, we will follow it until the first left curve, moment to go back down to the riverbed...

Return: (machine translated)

After the last rappel we will be attentive to the path of steps on the right.

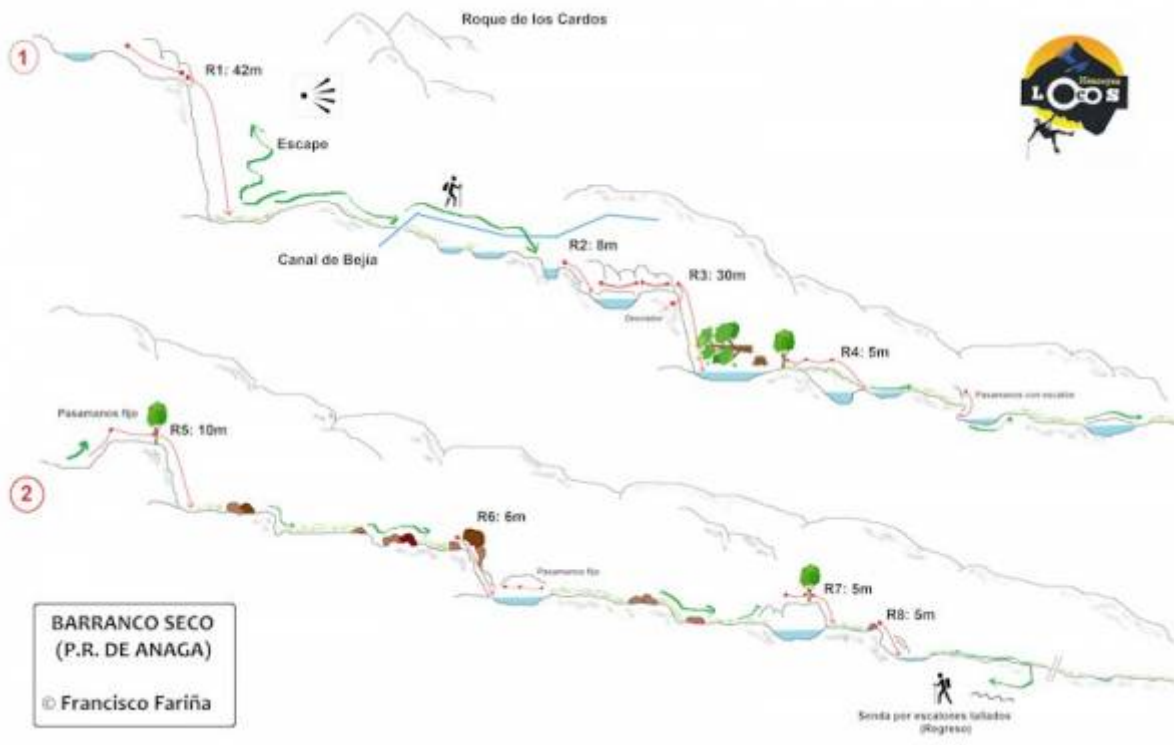
