| Summary: (machine translated) A polished, small and watery glacier stream with beautiful single sections and some slides and jumps. | | |
| Hydrology: (machine translated) Due to the altitude and location, there is snow for a long time. Therefore not accessible until around the beginning of August. The water level picture below shows little to medium flow. With more water, the narrow sections and pools can become somewhat more difficult. | | |
| Access: (machine translated) Take the Swiss A13 from Lake Constance southwards to Chur. Continue in the direction of San Bernardino and leave the A13 at exit 32 in the direction of the San Bernardino Pass. Drive over the mountain pass until it goes down again and park on the right at Alp Ca de Mucia (2'733'062.75, 1'149'240.97). Alternatively, take the next forest road immediately after the alp to point 1872 (2'732'931.12, 1'149'255.16). | | |
| Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot we can already see the canyon and the access. Follow the forest road to the wooden bridge. You can check the water level at the wooden bridge. Then follow the path (not marked but clearly visible) on the orthographic right-hand side of the canyon to the entry point. | | |
| Tour: (machine translated) At the beginning there is one rappel after the other. Beautifully polished rock with clear water in the pools. There are a few jumps and slides. In between, the canyon opens up and it is possible to get out. Smaller walking passages in the middle section. A few more rapells at the end. | | |
| Return: (machine translated) From the wooden bridge back up to the parking lot. | | |
