<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Normally largely dry hiking and rappel canyon with some marmitas trampas. Ideal with filled pools. With water flow at the exit dangerous siphon.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) After the A 7 has crossed the N 340, which is also a freeway, in the south of Valencia, we stay on the A 7 for another 62 km until we reach exit 61. Here we turn off onto the N 332 and continue for about 3 km to Oliva. From here, continue south on the CV 715 to Pego. From there, take the CV 712 in the direction of Vall d'Ebo. About 8 km after Pego we reach a plateau. Turn left at the replica of a windmill and continue for about 6 km (alternating between dirt road and tarred road) until you reach some houses on the right of the road. At the second junction of a tarred road to the west there is a signpost for hiking trails. Here we turn right, following the signpost 'PR-V147' and park the car in the open area in front of the houses (505 m above sea level).		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) We take the trail 'PR-V147', which first descends in a southwesterly direction, then making a wide arc to the north, to the spring fountain 'Font del Reinos'. Then it descends westward into the canyon of the Riu Girona (waypoint 38.788864, -0.136900 - 290 m a.s.l.). From here it is about 15 min. to the beginning of the Infern.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Up to 12 rappel; Partly difficult to go around the marmitas trampas or climb out of them.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) After the half-cave 'Cova Santa' and the exit of the technical-sporty part, we continue for about 30 minutes in the bed of the Rio Girona (keeping left at a fork). Then we reach the place where the path that descends from Fleix on the right slope in precise serpentine crosses the riverbed (180 m above sea level). We follow the path up the left slope until we reach the road again at the height. On it a few hundred meters and we are back at the signpost and the nearby car.
