Summary: (machine translated)

Canyoning in adventure terrain, fair facilities that will force us to carry reinstallation material and a long combination of vehicles that will make us think a lot about this canyoning. With flows in late spring or early autumn it is an adventure not to be missed.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

We have to go to San Juan de Plan, for this we arrive at Ainsa and take the A138 towards France. After Lafortunada and before reaching Bielsa we will have a detour to the right to Salinas, Valle de Chistau, Gistain, etc.. We will go along this road and pass Plan and soon San Juan de Plan.

We will continue along the road to Gistain, soon a left fork and straight ahead, going up the Cinqueta river, the track that goes up to Viados. We will go along it for a couple of kilometers, we cross the bridge of the Molín or Fondería and soon we arrive at the exit of the ravine of the Turno or Guarbena. Here we leave the car to return.

We return to San Juan de Plan, in the village road makes a turn to the left and a street to the right that becomes a track, we follow it and cross the Cinqueta (access to the ravine of Sen). We will have to follow it for about 11km until a couple of right-left hairpins right next to our ravine. We park

Approach: (machine translated)

Two possible accesses, from the right fork there is a path that crosses the stream (recommended).

We go up the trail until it crosses the stream, the first rappel right from here.

Tour: (machine translated)

From the track a first rappel and then a zone without more interest until the crossing with the path of the access 2. We will continue walking a while until arriving to some short rappels, after them the ravine opens again and after the right turn we arrive to the most interesting part 18+50+8+45 will wait for us to save this vertical. From here to the end, again a good time of walking along the riverbed interspersed with rappels of little interest. As a good alpine canyon, they are not totally vertical rappels, but they are very slippery and technical with flow. In fact, only the vertical rappels are worthwhile.

Precarious and opening equipment, with abundant naturals. The first rappel of the vertical is in a tree on the orographic left (hard to find).
