Summary: (machine translated) Climbing again with ascenders should be mastered! During our ascent, fixed ropes were available everywhere for the return ascent. However, one should not assume that the ropes are everywhere. Beautiful sinter curtains and washed out pools; the canyon opens into the sea; depending on the water level 1 siphon / clamping block; in summer mostly dry. If necessary, take rope remnants for resurgence.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Port de Soller at the 1st traffic circle in the direction of Soller. Drive through the tunnel and continue to the 2nd traffic circle. Turn left here towards Pollenca. Drive past the village of Fornalutx, after a narrow hairpin bend to the right, you will come to the "Mirador de Ses Barques" viewpoint (1st parking possibility). From the asphalt road at the viewpoint, follow the gravel road (large stones and holes!) down to the farmed "Balitx d'Avall" (limited parking possibility). If you want to park here, you should ask beforehand or have something to eat. Alternatively, the route can also be covered on foot (approx. 1 hour). Parking lot at the bottom: Direction Soller through the tunnel, at the traffic circle after the tunnel take the second exit and keep right at the next intersection. Follow this road until a small, steep road branches off to the left in a hairpin bend. Either park here or follow the small road up to the houses of S'iletta de Can Gordo (very narrow, bumpy and narrow hairpin bends).		

Approach: (machine translated)

From "Balitx d'Avall" do not climb straight into the streambed, but follow the path left. Climb over the fence and continue orographically to the right of the canyon, follow the gravel path for approx. 200m to an open area, here you can easily descend into the canyon (steps in the stone wall).

From the lower parking lot: from S'iletta de Can Gordo, follow the path towards the canyon, go over a gate before the second gate and descend briefly to the left to then immediately change to a beautiful path that runs horizontally over the cliffs. Follow the path until you reach a stone with red color markings, turn left down towards es Joncar, the exit from the sea, slightly uphill to the right the path leads to our ascent, the Pas d'es Heura. Follow the path into a saddle below a prominent rock tower (short climbing passage below a rock wall - do not climb up under the wall on the right). Behind the notch, descend fairly straight under the wall on the right, cross the valley and hike towards a rock amphitheater on the other side (cairns). If you only want to walk the lower part of the gorge, you can easily reach the stream here by descending through the valley. Climb over a rock ramp to the upper edge of the rock amphitheater and follow the climbing tracks and cairns for about 200m until you reach a sand road. Either follow this sand road uphill until another road branches off to the left, or onto the secondary ridge that drops into the Balitx valley on its right side and stay on it (stone wall) until you can descend to the right over steep forest terrain. You end up in a mostly dry side ditch which you follow to the Torrent de Na Mora. There is a lot of disseminated grass and sharp-edged rocks - long trousers pay off.

Tour: (machine translated)

The Na Mora is a beautiful and not too demanding canyon with some nice pools to jump. Since usually back up through the canyon on fixed ropes, it should not be underestimated in terms of strength. The canyon can be divided (1st part to Cala Ferrera) or further to the sea. The 1st part is very open with only a few narrows. From the middle (Cala Ferrera) the canyon becomes increasingly narrow and continuous. If the water level allows it, the rope can be omitted except for a few places (! only for the descent!) Alternating jumps, downclimb, slide and short swimming passages follow before you reach the sea.

Mostly all rappels (12m,6m,10m,9m,10m,5m) are equipped with fixed ropes which allow you to climb back over the ropes (ascenders!) if the way over the sea is not possible. However, you should not rely on the presence of these ropes and take enough rope yourself. \Once at the sea, swim out through a narrow channel, then turn left and swim through two bays before coming ashore in front of a rock about 15m high (impossible even with moderate waves, so watch the weather forecast). Swimming distance about 500m. In the erosion slope above the rock begins a path that leads steeply and with difficulty back to the access path.

Return: (machine translated)

Our recommendation is to climb back up the canyon. Alternatively, can be left via the via ferrata-like exit before the sea (but long way back 2-3h).
