Summary: (machine translated)

Limestone; in the 1st part partly turbid water due to sandy bottom; from the middle worthwhile; mostly little water, but large catchment area; several rappelling points in the watercourse; partly slippery; well equipped; Questionable is the prohibition sign of Vione 2, since outdoor operators also offer the 2nd part; ticket for the 2nd part not necessary; risk of burglary at the parking entry.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

From Torbole, take the "SS45bis" through Riva and Limone to "Prato della Fama". Here you park the shuttle car if you take the Johanna 2 (Vione 2) (parking possibilities next to the road or at the small harbor in front of the tunnel. €5,- day parking ticket)). With the 2nd car, continue through the long tunnel and turn right towards Tignale. From here, follow the mountain road for approx. 5 km, which then meets a bridge (exit Vione 1 or entry Vione 2). It is better to park your car in the direction of Piovere after the first hairpin bend at a turnout due to the risk of burglary. To walk the entire canyon (Vione 1+2), drive up towards Piovere as far as the 2nd hairpin bend. Here you follow the poorly asphalted road 252 (marked on the stone) right up to hiking trail 265 Tignale-Aer. Limited parking at the left bend at 460Hm.

Approach: (machine translated)

At a parking bay approx. 150m below the road bridge, a trail leads into the streambed. You reach the canyon above a scree dam.

Tour: (machine translated)

The first half of the tour is a forest gorge in layered limestone, with many walking passages and short abseils and is not yet very convincing. Only from the middle does the canyon become more continuous and worthwhile. Here, several abseils (some of them jumpable) follow one another without a long route. The highlight of the tour is the 50m rappel. This is best rappelled from the left. The right-hand belay is difficult to reach. This is followed by a short step and a walking passages before the stream flows into Lake Garda (65m). Bar at the bottom.

Return: (machine translated)

Arrived at the lake (65Hm)go back to the parking lot on the left.
