Summary: (machine translated) A long and strenuous tour along the southern slope of Mount Gerbonte.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Access to the valley: From the Arma di Taggia toll booth, drive down to the center and follow the signs for Triora and the Argentina Valley. Park in a small clearing on the left, 300 m after the village of Creppo, near a white sign. Access from the mountain (1) By off-road vehicle: continue along the valley as far as Realdo, after the village follow the dirt road that leads to the high route up to the junction for Monte Gerbonte. (2) Hairpin bends back into the valley as far as the village of Molini di Triora, turn right towards Colle della Melosa and continue to the summit. Park near the clearing in front of the Allavena hut. With an off-road vehicle you can reach the Gray hut and continue to the junction for the Gerbonte.		
Approach:		
Tour: (machine translated) three 60 m ropes, a well-equipped equipment bag and a headlamp A long and strenuous tour along the southern slope of Mount Gerbonte. An initially dry but completely vertical part is followed by a long, wet march with numerous descents and unsecured rocky parts. The jagged limestone landscape makes for an interesting descent. A harness bag and a headlamp are essential. From the foot of the 150 mark, the canyon turns left and extends over a part of at least 200 meters above sea level that is still unexplored. We turned right towards Cugnazzo, following a steep rocky ridge but with trees for anchoring. 7, 10, 15, 20, 25, 60, 60, 30 and some trees
