Summary: (machine translated) Not very interesting canyon, longer running sections at the beginning. The exit is certainly suitable for people who have never been canyoning before.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Medium-sized catchment area, mostly throughout the summer.		
Access: (machine translated) Park at the bottom in Montreux, unless you also want to do the upper part.		
Approach: (machine translated) There is a hiking trail along the canyon. If you want to start at the top, enter at 810m, otherwise at P. 537		
Tour: (machine translated) Two parts with about 4 rappels each, in between a very long walking passage where it is best to return to the hiking trail. Upper part hardly worthwhile. In the lower part there is sometimes a 5m jump.		
Return: (machine translated) You can get back quickly via the hiking trail.
