Tour: (machine translated) You start at the right tributary, then switch to the left at the hiking trail. At the top, some of the rappels are nicely polished, the further down it goes, the more bouldery it becomes.		
Return: (machine translated) At the confluence with the Rottalbach, cross the field to get back to the bridge at Trachsellaunen.
