We must be located in Igueste, next to Candelaria.

Location of Igueste-Hondo ravines

We will go up Igueste to Ajoreña street (ascending), then Maja street,... up to La Jimena street, we will follow it until it becomes a dirt track, you can park next to a water tank. If we have a high car we follow the track another 100m until we meet the Araya canal or further to the end of the track.

The return vehicle will have been left on the TF-28 at the p.k. 13,2 next to the bridge over the Los Poqueros river, next to the Agrícola bar.

We will follow the track until, after passing over the ravine of the Juncos, it ends. We will continue to the right on a paved path that leads us to our ravine.
