Access: (machine translated) From Vancouver toward Squamish on Highway 99 to Britannia Beach. Follow Cooper Dr. to the parking lot—where the paved road turns into a gravel road. Space for two vehicles.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot, follow the hiking trail to the entry for about 5 minutes.		
Tour: (machine translated) A varied route with slides, jumps, and beautiful rappels in lovely gneiss. There are usually two bolts. When the water level is high, the narrow sections can be easily bypassed. There are plenty of exits in the upper section.		
Return: (machine translated) Exit on the left under the second bridge and head up toward the street.
