From Bierge in the direction of Alquezar, after a few kilometers, you reach the bridge over the Isuala, the end point of the Balcés Estrechos. About 100 m after the turnoff to this village and before reaching the plateau, we turn left onto a dirt road, which we always follow in a basically northerly direction. Before a short ascent, which seems no longer drivable for normal cars, we park the second car.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

If you have only 1 vehicle available, we recommend the access from the bridge over the Isuala as described and sketched in the above-mentioned Internet site. Otherwise, we follow the track from the 2nd vehicle further up the climb, on the right past a dilapidated house and then always following the signs for a mountain bike tour ('10'). After about 1 hour we reach the ridge where further down is the Erimitage de la Viren de la Vina, which can be seen from afar on the left as we climb. However, we cross the ridge and follow a path that passes above the 2 branches of the Bco. Vina to then reach the next Bco. the Cerrigüelo. Already from the saddle we move down the left slope of the Cerrigüelo pathless through scrub and undergrowth to the stream that has some water even in midsummer.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Only recommended for lovers also of hiking in unspoiled scenery. Also then the neighboring Pallas to the north more recommended.

**Return:** (machine translated)

You can go back up the next barranco, the Vina (all climbable), but this is not recommended because the exit up to the Hermitage is difficult to find and arduous. It is better to go down the Estrechos de Balcés until the bridge over the Isuala and the lower vehicle.
