Zbuciumatul Valley, located in the Făgăraș Mountains near Stâna lui Burnei and Rea Canyon, fed by the waters of Lake Galbena, hosts one of the most impressive waterfalls in Romania. Traversing this technical canyon involves a high level of commitment due to large vertical drops and the lack of artificial anchors, requiring many improvisations and thorough knowledge of rope management and friction handling.
