Classic route, aquatic, quite spectacular and relatively short, which brings together a good number of attractions. Chaos, narrow, dark and almost subway route, some rappel, all well condensed, dosed and ordered. Main problem, the volume of people. Choose the right time of the year and the right moment.

**Hydrology:**

**Access:** (machine translated)

On the highway from Huesca to Barbastro, take exit 77 towards Abiego/Alquézar. Arriving at Abiego turn towards Bierge on the A1227.

On the HU-341 road, before Almunias, we turn off on a very prominent track (next to the Barranco Fondo signpost), pass the Balced viewpoint and continue to the esplanade (where the signpost is located).

**Approach:** (machine translated)

We continue on foot along the track until we reach the top, we pass the fence and border the Isuala river hill on our right, we pass through the stone quarry and continue until we find a path on our right downhill that leads us to the riverbed.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

The descent begins in a gigantic chaos, very curious, that will require the use of the rope and will force you to look for a way out among the rocks.

the exit among the rocks. The gorge closes and forces us to enter a long aquatic corridor through a minimal overhang, to which the darkness and the force of the water give the right atmosphere. The corridor, very narrow and in chiaroscuro, quite long, leads to a waterfall of a few meters, main difficulty and key step. Attention to the flow and the waterfall itself.

**Return:** (machine translated)

Follow the river up to a wide badina closed by a small strait, where the basin opens up. At

On the right bank, heading NW, there is a well-marked path that, among pines and boxwoods, will leave us again at the Colmenares pass, close to where we left the car.

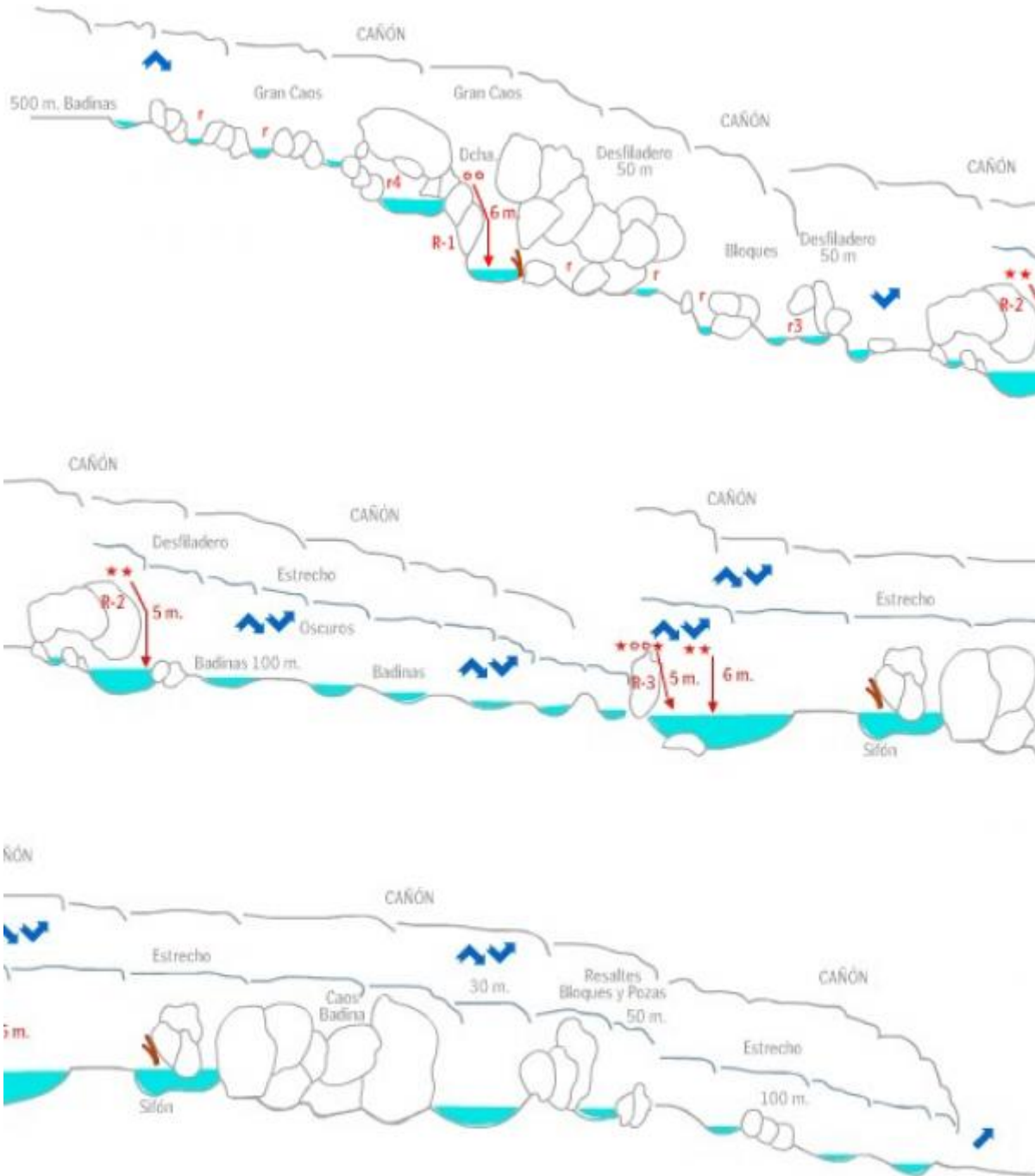
