Note: when the water stops flowing, the pools tend to rot and it is not advisable to do it. It also has a lot of vegetation that makes it difficult to walk.

We have to be located in the NW of the island, next to the Natural Park of Tamadaba, in the town of El Risco. Location of the banks Palmar, Juanjorro, Laurel, Molina and Vaquero.

We will take the GC2 to El Risco where we will take the GC200 southbound, when entering El Risco we have a parking lot on the right to visit the Charco Azul.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

By the path of the Cuesta de Lopez, equal access to Lomo Molina and Laurel.

When you reach the top, after passing the Cuevecillas and before reaching the track of Lomo de la Huerta, we will turn left following a path that passes through the riverbed of Laurel, we cross it and continue a while more until the next riverbed that is ours.
