Summary:

Remote & vertical canyon on top of the Cadini del Brenton. Last waterfalls used to be an iceclimbing spot. Currently forbidden & heavily controlled.

Hydrology:

To do after snowmelt or rain. Possibility of starting at source alt. 900m.

Access:

Approach:

Approach via the Cadini, trails 4b+8a to alt. 820m.

Additional waterfall at alt. 880m. can be accessed in different ways.

Possibility to start even higher, but morphology & little water make it not interesting.

Tour:

An L 45m

1 Tebylon ring 6cm bolt R + a pre-drilled hole 10cm, in a niche, 20m

Downclimb

An L 20m

Chain (home-made but inox) R 25m

Confluenza

An R 20m

An R 20m fixed rope, cheap maillon

An L 15m fixed rope, cheap maillon

Chain L 40m, in a niche

2 bolts Tebylon 45m L

An R rope, cheap maillon 30m, double drop

2 bolts/spits (iceclimbing) R rope, cheap maillon 25m, freehanging

Return:

Hike the Brenton valley down or descend the touristic Cadini (attention: no anchors, when you jump down into a pool, you may face obligatory jumps/slides of up to 10m). The exit is checked regularly by police.
