Either from the direction of Cuneo or from the Roya Valley we come to Borgo San Dalmazzo. From here we take the SS21 and go up the valley of the Stura di Demonte via Demonte and Vinadio, passing Sambuco. Immediately after the last houses of Sambuco the road crosses the Rio Bianco/Bandia. Immediately after the bridge we park our car in a suitable place.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

From here a trail leads up to Moriglione S. Lorenzo. We cross the hamlet and take the path to Sambuco, which takes us through the hamlet of Moriglione di Fondo to the footbridge at the exit from the upper section of the stream. Here we enter the lower part.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Longer stretches of walking and descending. 6-10 rappel, the 31m rappel just before the water diversion (A1 - about 1250m altitude). After the water diversion still a good hour downhill to the exit A2 at the old road bridge (under this bridge another 2m slide).

**Return:** (machine translated)

At A1 after the water diversion out onto the footbridge, there right up to Moriglione S. Lorenzo and to the car at P1. Alternatively, continue downstream to the exit A2 (if necessary, take the 2m slide under the old road bridge). It should also be considered that in an integral ascent (Bandia + Bianco) only one gets off at A1 and fetches the car at P1, but the others descend completely to A2.
