Summary: (machine translated)

Also known as the left tributary of the Pantanet which over the years has been unequipped.

Dry, open ravine, with a lot of vegetation and even in some points it is a nuisance for collectors.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

We must get to Alfafara. Take the A7 to Muro de Alcoy, exit on the CV700, cross Muro and continue straight ahead. After passing Agres we will arrive at Alfafara.

Access Vinyes and Pantanet

We cross the village of Alfafara and a kilometer and a little further on there is a detour to the right towards a rural house. We get into this small road, we leave the rural house on the left and after a couple of curves we arrive at a bridge over the stream. We will park here.

Approach: (machine translated)

Approach Vinyes and Pantanet

We will cross the bridge and follow the path that runs parallel to the river we will pass in front of a farmhouse in ruins and behind it we will descend to the river in search of an easy way to cross.

Once we cross, we will ascend along the walls and the slope that go above the riverbed and following the milestones, in the direction of the antennas as a reference until the last one that will deposit us in the watercourse of this ravine and we will descend by the blurred and dressed path to the beginning of the ravine.

Tour: (machine translated)

It could be an interesting descent but the undergrowth in the area makes progression difficult, better if we go with pruning shears. A few short rappels lead us to the final vertical above the Pantanet.

(Contribution)

We will begin with a handrail of 15 m which avoids all the vegetation that there is in the channel (recommended rope between 8 and 9) to continue by a small rappel of 7 m which will leave us in a fractional of 10 m, to continue descending bordering the channel of the ravine by its right side which is overdressed.

We will arrive at a bifurcation and we will continue towards the left to continue with the bordering of the dressed riverbed, until arriving at a vertical and to our left we will find the head of 15 m which will deposit us out of the vegetation to next take the rappel of 10 m and fractioning with the rappel of 10 m which leaves us in a pool where we find the last rappel of 12 m.

Once down we will only have to climb up to the river.

Return: (machine translated)

We will follow the riverbed upwards at first on the right along an old path following the milestones and the path which will change sides several times until we reach the parking lot.
