Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) How to get to Valle del Gran Rey We will need two cars to get to Valle del Gran Rey. The return car on the ascent from La Caleta to Arure, past El Retamal we have three very tight hairpins, in the first left, before the tunnel, there is a detour to the right to "Los Descansaderos", for 50m here until the right turn just at the exit of the ravine. With the access car we will continue climbing towards Arure, just in the ascent, when arriving, we have a detour to the right towards Las Hayas. After passing the cemetery, which is on the left, 250m we have a track on the right that goes down to the reservoir (access Hayas). We continue along the road and cross the stream of Las Hayas, the road rises slightly to a small hill with a left curve, on the right is a street (road Lo Vasco), where we will go down to the dry riverbed.		
Approach: (machine translated) Bcos Valle del Gran Rey We will follow the riverbed up to the first difficulties		
Tour: (machine translated) A very vertical first part that will not allow us any type of error (only for experienced people) and a second part of narrow, very dressed and delicate skills.		
Return: (machine translated) Once it opens, we go out to the left to the terraces that we must go down to the road that we will see down there.

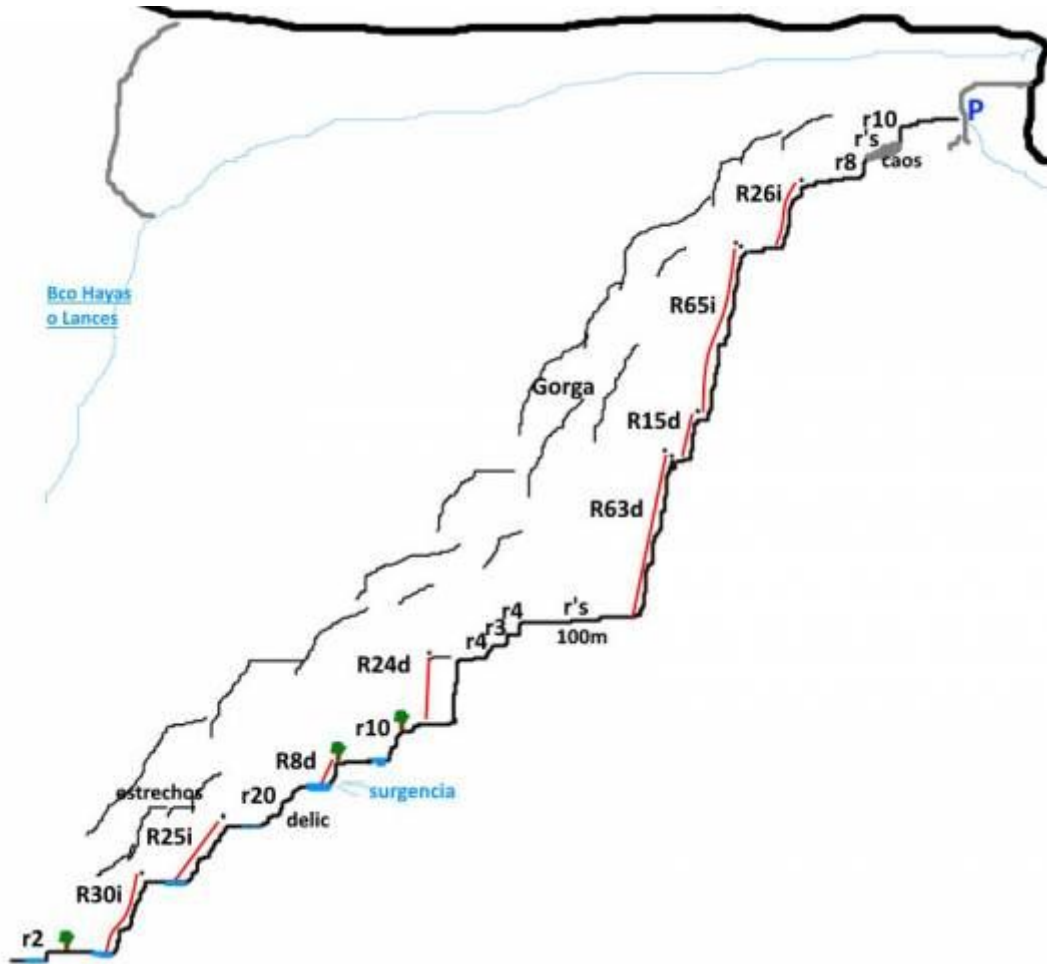
