Situating us in the Anaga Park by the TF12, up to p.k. 20.9 right next to the turnoff to Taborno we have the picnic area Casa Carlos where we park the access vehicle.

If we have two vehicles we will take the detour to Taborno to go down a little more than three kilometers to a crossroads where we will continue to the right to Taborno and then another kilometer to a left curve, past this there is a small hole in which to leave the vehicle.
