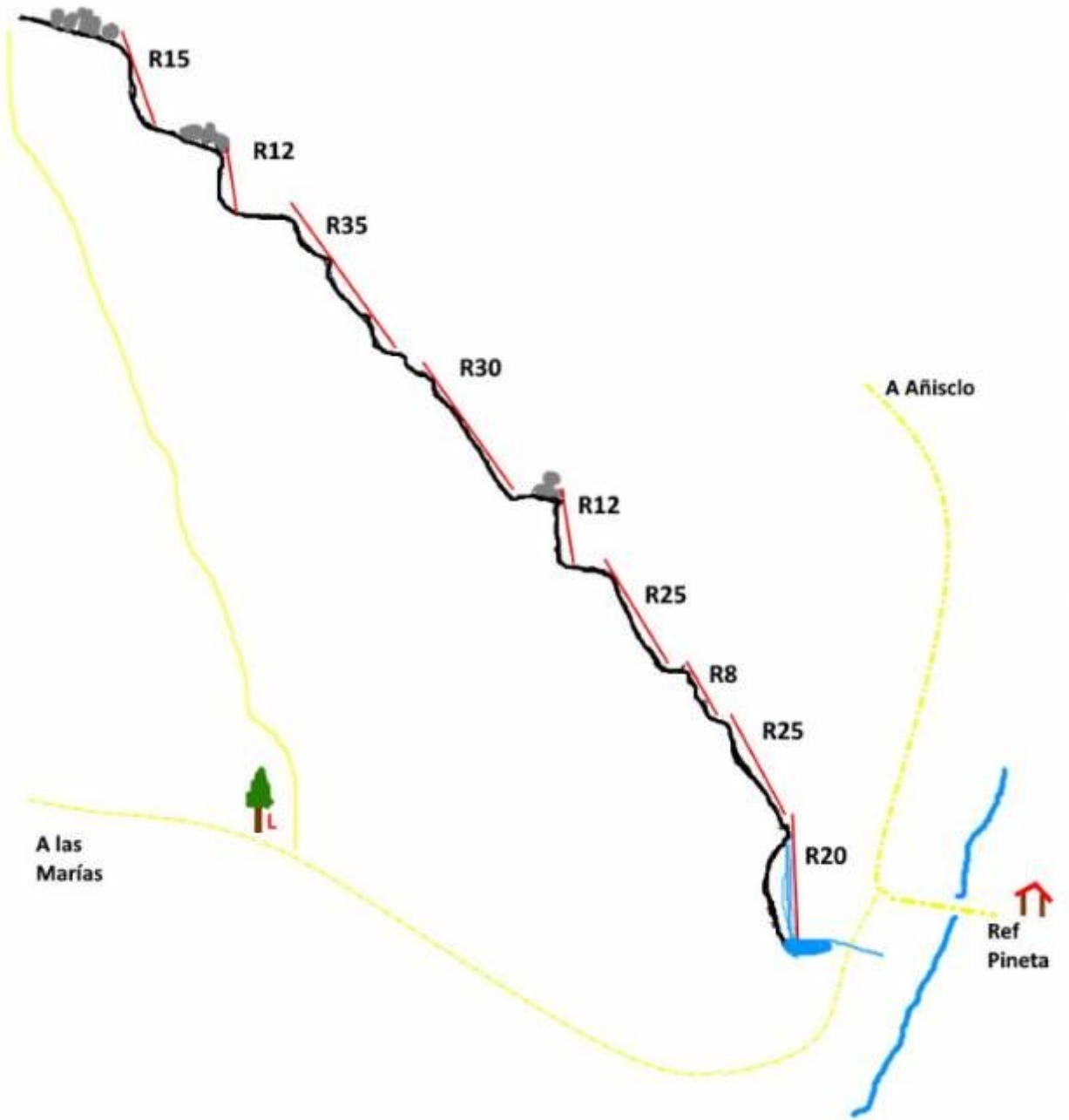

The access is a bit hard and maybe a little bit losing in the final part when we leave the Marias trail.   |                                    |                                       |

| <b>Access:</b> (machine translated)<br>From Ainsa on the N260 we turn towards France on the A138 until we reach Bielsa. Here we turn left towards the valley of Pineta and the Parador. Halfway, we find the Pineta refuge, where we will park.   |                                    |                                       |
| <b>Approach:</b> (machine translated)<br>We leave by the path of the Añisclo pass and, before starting to climb, we turn left onto the path of Las Marías. Soon we enter the forest and pass the end of our ravine and its last waterfall. We will continue for about 150m and the trail turns right to climb the slope towards Las Marias. At a turn, at about 1400m altitude, we will see a pine tree with a red L-shaped mark, a place to leave the path and go right towards the ravine.                      |                                    |                                       |
