Summary: (machine translated) Rappel canyon with many smaller steps, nicely continuous and without getting too technical.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Lots of vegetation in the catchment area, you should wait a few days after heavy rain. Should not be entered if the measuring station at Brenno still has over 5 cubic meters.		
Access: (machine translated) There is not much space to park directly at the top, so perhaps it is best to stop at the bends before the turn-off.		
Approach: (machine translated) At the bridge at 1009m you can walk down into the streambed, and in a little more than 100m the canyon begins.		
Tour: (machine translated) The canyon actually has the same ambience throughout. Small steps rappeling in the water, in a constant 10-30m gulch. An emergency exit is often possible every 5 rappels (even if it is often steep up the slope). There are three larger waterfalls during the tour, with the very large one being the crux of the tour.		
Return: (machine translated) You can park right by the bridge at 618m and walk well out of the streambed. The last 2 steps under the bridge are nothing special and after that you end up in nowhere.
