<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Very long and narrow canyon through dark slate. Known as "one of the most committing canyons" in New Zealand. The "Slot of Doom" part is a highlight.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Queenstown -> Glenorchy -> Paradise/Diamond Lake -> Glenorchy-Paradise Rd until you cross the streambed (= just before the exit of the road/Chinaman's Bluff). Here you can park next to the road on the meadows.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Water level: to check the water level, walk upstream from the parking lot for about 20 minutes until you reach a confluence. Further access: in the middle between the two converging rivers, follow a path that is difficult to see up to the respective contour lines (entry "Les Haut": approx. 1300m, "Superiore": approx. 1050m, "Intermedio": approx. 900m and "Inferiore": approx. 800m). "Les Haut" is the only entry that can be reached on foot. For all other entries, you have to rappel into the streambed. Access depending on the access height: 2-4h		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Times in the canyon depending on entry: "Les Haut" approx. 10h, "Superiore" approx. 8h, "Intermedio" approx. 7h, "Inferiore" approx. 4h.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) At approx. 600m, exit the stream to the left at a confluence and follow the access route back to the parking lot (approx. 2h).
