<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Hardly any catchment area, so not much flowing water, but surprisingly deep pools.			
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Leave one car in Zhonggou and take a car to the village north of where the hiking trail starts.			
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) About 800m up the mountain, on the plateau at the top it is best to stay on the path until you reach the dry streambed, and follow it until the first pools appear.			
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Very narrow at the top, you can't progress very quickly. Anchors need to be replaced. There seems to be a place in the middle where you need a headlamp. Vertical at the exit.
