Summary: (machine translated)

Beautiful, vertical lime canyon with many rappels, including 3 high (40-50m); mostly little water; steep access; some sharp edges and slippery places; ideal with small groups; several exposed belays; rope technically demanding!; Attention at the final rappel --> 25m with redirection right directly to the 45m rappel (! sharp edge, at the chain anchor place for max. 3 people); beautiful view

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

approx. 30min

From Bovec drive in the direction of Tarvisio (N) after approx. 3km take the right turn Kransjka Gora/ Trenta --> place Soca --> place Pri Cerkvi --> after a hairpin bend follow the road for a short time until you see a walled cemetery on the right side --> park here on the left at the gravel turnout.

Approach: (machine translated)

approx. 40-45min

From the parking lot go down a few steps to the Soca --> cross the Soca --> you are now directly at the mouth of the Podolu stream --> follow the narrow path directly to the left of the Podolu --> after approx. 5min. you come to the final waterfall (approx. 700Hm) (water quantity control) --> here it goes left over a steep way (left) approx. 40-45min uphill (partly with steel rope secured way) --> after approx. 200Hm it becomes flatter --> one follows the way up to the already visible brook (entry on approx. 900Hm).

Tour: (machine translated)

approx. 3-3,5h

The Poule has a very vertical character, high and low abseils alternate continuously (in the canyon, which usually has only little water) --> beginners have lost nothing here, because some abseils are mentally and technically demanding --> if you have a good rope technique and are familiar with exposed places, you will feel comfortable in this canyon --> there are only a few pools that are suitable for jumping or slides --> the beautiful view of the Soca Valley and the surrounding mountains are also a good reason to walk in this canyon - -> you should be prepared for the last 2 abseils-> you should plan for the last 2 rappel points some time --> to prevent a pendulum here, first set up a 25m traverse to the exposed stand (right) (the rope traverse can be redirected in the middle) --> at the last rappel (45m overhanging), you should pay particular attention to the sharp edge (work rope gently).

Return: (machine translated)

approx. 5min

You get out of the stream directly after the last rappel on the right (approx. 700Hm) --> follow the path that went up before back to the parking lot.
