Summary: (machine translated) Rappel canyon at the beginning of a great canyon		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Approach either from Rome (approx. 100 km from the junction with the A-1) or from Pescara / Adria (approx. 100 km from the junction with the A-14), either way on the A-24.At the Celano exit (approx. 12 km east of Avezzano), turn off towards Celano and continue northwards up to Ovindoli (1379 m above sea level). Shortly after Ovindoli, a road - which later becomes a dirt track - leads in an easterly direction. Keep to the right for about 4 km across the plateau to its exit. Where hiking trail no. 12 leaves the plateau to the southeast (first slightly uphill, then descending into the Gole di Celano), park the car.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot, turn north, cross the stream, see a fountain on the righthand side, pass it and follow the course of the stream on the orographic left. At 1220 m above sea level you come to the actual entry into the canyons.		
Tour: (machine translated) The somewhat different forest gorge - not without charm. After this tour, you can also walk down the entire canyon on the hiking trail, but you should then have parked a second vehicle at the exit of the canyon. To do this, just before (below) the village of Celano, follow the signs for 'la Foce' eastwards along a dirt road to the parking lot not far from the canyon exit.		
Return: (machine translated) After the last 9m rappel, which can be bypassed on the left, continue walking along the streambed, past the 'Fonte degli Innamorati' (1029m), until you meet the crossing trail n. 12. Follow it up to the right (also orographic right) to reach the car.
