**Hydrology:**

**Access:** (machine translated)

On the N230 between Pont de Suert and Vielha.

At the height of p.k. 149.5 towards Vielha, we have on the right the detour to the refuge of Conangles. We parked

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Approach by wooded area at all times, a cool and very pleasant approach in summer.

We leave by the Besiberri track (south direction) after 5 minutes we turn left to the Besiberri ravine. The track is making big loops, along the path we can go shortening. When we take about 40 min, at an altitude of 1660m, the track goes south across the ravine, this is the access to the bottom.

We continue on the trail up the orographic right less than 1km to 1770m, where the trail crosses the ravine, exit of the upper part. We will continue climbing, now on the orographic left, in a continuous zig-zag until we surpass the walls that enclose the Besiberri Lake, along its shore we will go to the drainage area, the beginning of the Upper Besiberri.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Very alpine descent, the upper part with less water but longer rappels. The lower part is more flowing.

In between, the intermediate zone is of no interest.

**Return:** (machine translated)

From the upper part, just as the trail crosses the ravine.

From the lower part, when we reach the bridge of the track below, we will have to go up the track to the car.
