From Gonnosfaniga we take Via Pietro Bonelli and follow the sign "Santa Severa". At the chapel we take the road that runs first uin northwestern direction. After 950m we take the dirt road to the hamlet of Togoro. !,3 km after that we come to a junction where we turn right. Another 2.5 km further on a dirt road goes off to the left. Here we park the car.

#### Approach: (machine translated)

We take the mule track on the left. It leads us - past a ruined house - into the streambed of Gutturu Fenugu.
