Summary: (machine translated) Vertical canyon, until the 150m rappel was split, it was the highest. Only for very experienced people. Prohibited between December and June		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Access to Foratata, Chines, Isarre Sup and Buitrera banks. We must be located in Santa Eulalia la Mayor. For it by the N240 direction Lleida we will go to Loporzano. From here to Sasa de Abadiado by the HU330 and here we continue to Castilsabás where we turn left to Santa Eulalia. We will continue along the track that comes out after crossing the village, next to the church. After a few kilometers we arrive at a crossroads in the form of "Y", to the right we will go down towards the parking of the return car (Ermita de San Chinés). On this track towards the hermitage we will go until we find a chain, if it is not closed we will go to the same access of the hermitage. With the access car we will go to the left towards Puntas de Baíl until we find a sharp right curve where we will find a chain.		
Approach: (machine translated) Access to the Foratata, Chines, Isarre Sup and Buitrera banks. We will continue towards Bail along the path and we will find a left curve where there is a panel to La Matosa where we will go along this well-marked path to the rock bridge at the entrance to the ravine.		
Tour: (machine translated) A first very narrow part that we can descend in opposition until we reach the perforated marmita that we will rappel. Here we will enter an area of chaos where there is an old maquis shelter. We will be under the visor. Just out of this area we enter the great vertical.		
Return: (machine translated) When we reach the end, we will be at the Isarre riverbank, which we can descend or take the San Chinés Hermitage path to go to the track of the return car.

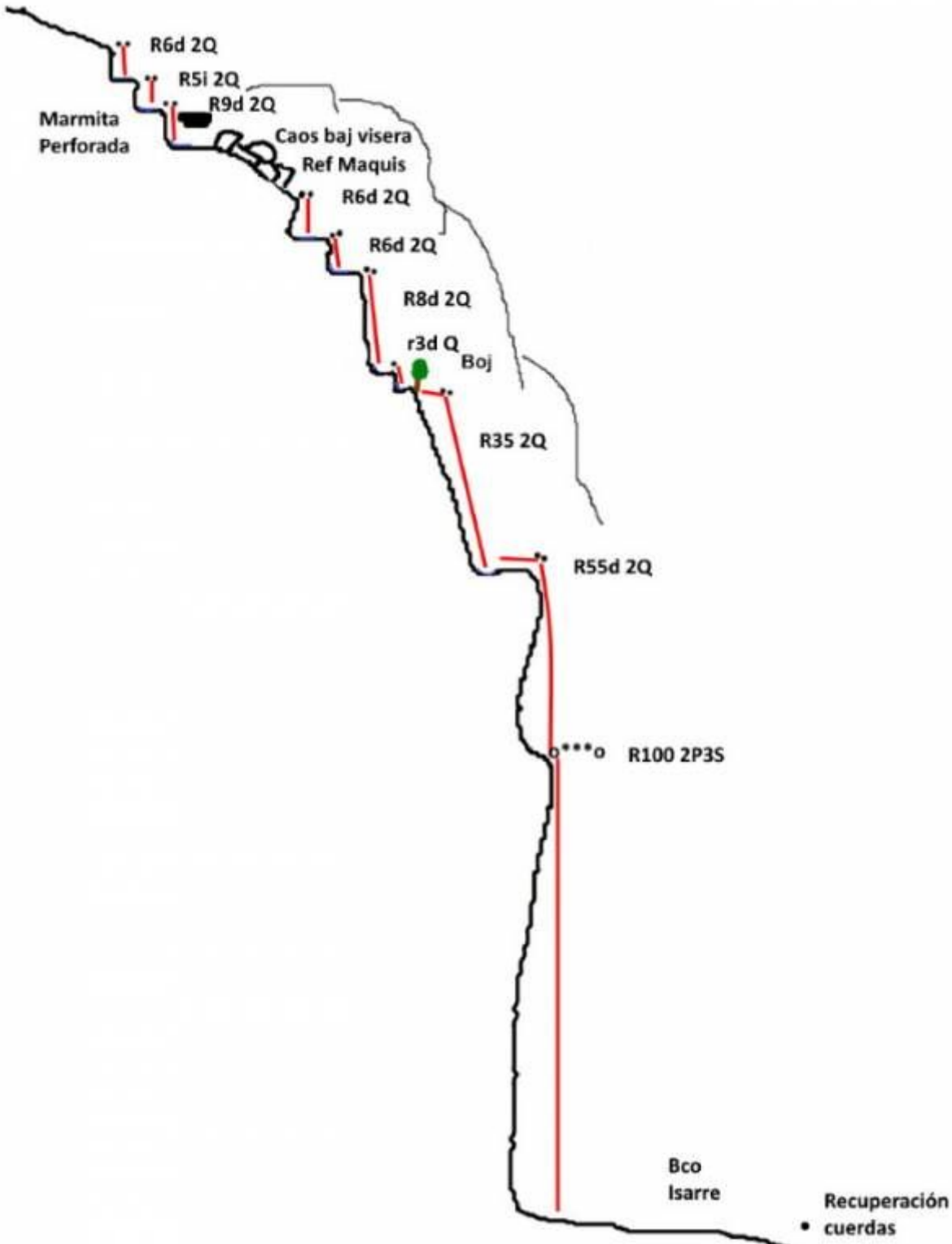
