Access to Bcos de la Terreta

At p.k. 103, after the detour to Arén, we have the detour to the right to La Terreta. We will find the detour to the left and Els Massos de Tamurcia that we will leave behind, we will pass by Tamurcia where we have the sign of Espluga de la Serra at 5.2 km. We will follow the road until there where we will park.

If we want to combine vehicles we will follow the track with the return vehicle 1km until we cross the stream.

Accesses to St Miquel, Corneli and Colliró bcos

By the path of ascent to the Pic de Llerás (there are many tracks of hiking routes of this area), we will arrive at the crest where we will go to the south, to the coll del Serradell, about 500m later there is a path on the right that takes us to the basin of our ravine, we can go down by the riverbed or follow a track abandoned by the orographic right to go down to the area of the cut ones.
