Summary: (machine translated) Impressive scenic approach, then rappel in a homogeneous and winding gorge. Somewhat slippery, and lots of fixed ropes.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Oviedo on the A-66 south, in the direction of Leon. After about 52 km we come to a long tunnel, which we drive through. Now we can already see Caldas de Luna on the righthand side . However, we still have to go through the next tunnel and immediately after that we turn off onto the CL-626. 1,5 km after leaving the highway, we turn left on the bridge that will take us to the road that will bring us to Calda de Luna. In front of the church, we go up on the left until we reach the streambed, where we leave our car.		
Approach: (machine translated) We now walk up the slope in a north-westerly direction, at about halfway up the path turns to the NNE and we reach the saddle. Down the other side and in a long right-hand bend we reach the stream above the rocky ledges.		
Tour: (machine translated) 7 rappels, an attractive narrow section; at the exit of the narrow section turn right onto the path.		
Return: (machine translated) Down the path to the road and the car.

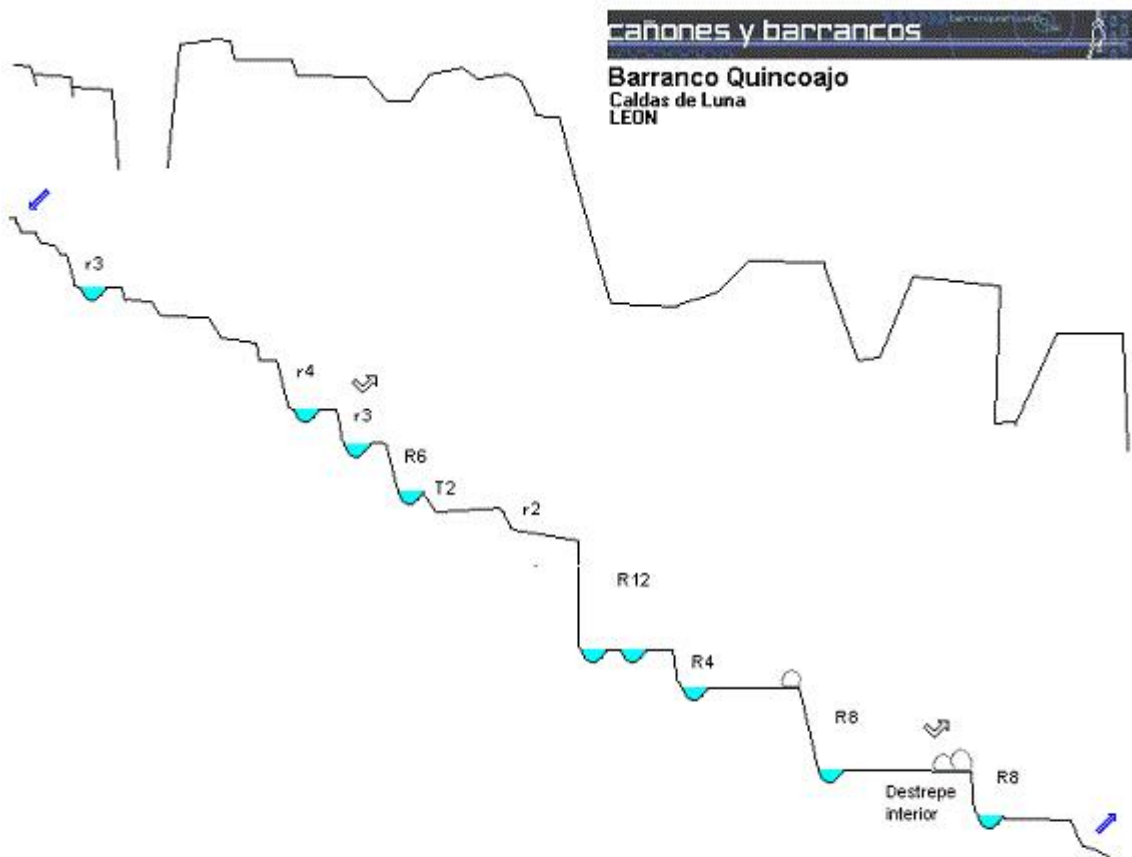
