Summary: (machine translated) Water poor forest canyon		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Leave the highway from Imperia in the direction of France at Ventimiglia and take the SS 1 (Aurelia) back east to Imperia. Approx. 2 km after the center of Ventimiglia, the SP64 branches off to the north towards Dolceacqua. Follow this road via Isolabona to Pigna. About 600m before reaching the village, turn left onto Corso Lodovico Isnardi (18 km from the junction with the SP64). After 75m, the road bends to the right, but we continue straight on. After another 600 m we come to a hairpin bend (to the right). We park our car here.		
Approach: (machine translated) We walk on the road (after the hairpin bend) continuing slightly uphill, passing the cemetery on the right and after 750 m (from the car) we come to the church of Nostra Signora di Lourdes (310 m altitude). Here we leave the tarred road and follow the Calvary path uphill in a basically northerly direction. At a junction we take the mule track to the left. At the next junction, take the path to the right and on it you will reach the bridge over the Rio Campali (entry).		
Tour: (machine translated) At the beginning, some nice rappel. After the C 38 then quite forest ditch-like, until the rappel again somewhat higher shortly before the exit of the tour. Exit then at the remains of a bridge.		
Return: (machine translated) After the exit we take the path to the left and in a few minutes we get to the car.
