The Echo canyon is a descent over the Giants, in its great crevasse, where we will end up on the beach of the Echo, so we must study the tides and wait for low tide. Very vertical, exposed and without the possibility of regrouping, all members must know perfectly the techniques of descent.

For the return, a boat must be waiting for us near the beach and we must swim out.

Descent prohibited during the period of bird reproduction, from February 1 to June 30, you must also request permission in the Teno Park or in the Cabildo.

DESCENT PROHIBITED, the Cabildo does not give permission for sport descent under any circumstances

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

We will be located in the port of Los Gigantes, where we will leave a vehicle and we will have agreed with a boat of the village the pick up time.

With the access car we will go up to Tamaimo, after passing the p.k 1, just before the cemetery, there is a sharp right curve and a track on the left. We park here next to the restaurant

Approach: (machine translated)

Along the track and take the first on the right (this track could be accessed for almost a kilometer with the access vehicle, next to the bco Santiago).

Take the next track to the left, downhill for about 500m to leave the PR-TF65 and go right up the hill of the mountain. Once on the ridge we leave the trail and go to the left, through the mountain, without losing height towards Degollada Bermeja and from there to the Alto del Gigante, we go around it "from behind" and we will stop our descent.
