We drive over the Staffen bridge at the mountain rescue Kössen and follow the road to the parking lot Karalm. There is a parking lot where you can buy a parking ticket.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

We head towards Haus Jägerklause and turn west onto a forest road. At the next junction, we follow the right-hand path until we reach the river bed.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

This is a tour with several short rappels, as well as several small jumps and slides, especially towards the exit of the canyon.

Particular attention should be paid to local residents, as there have been disputes between the landowners and the canyoning companies on site.

**Return:** (machine translated)

At the bridge, we climb orographically left out of the riverbed and follow the path until we reach the same path we took to the canyon.
