Access: (machine translated) In Almuñecar, leave the N 340 from Málaga to Almería at the traffic circle and turn off in the direction of Otivar. Drive through Otivar and continue on the main road towards Granada. Shortly after Otivar, the road to Lentegí branches off to the right. Continue straight on here, taking a left-hand bend over the Rio Lentegí and upwards in hairpin bends. 3.3 km after the Lentegí junction, a road descends to the left, signposted Central de Cázulas. Continue straight ahead on the main road and one kilometer further on turn left through a metal gate set back from the road about 10 m onto a wide dirt road (signposted Proprieta Privada, Junta de los Rios). This access road is subject to a toll (2016: 5 euros per car, 5 euros per person) Tel. on site: 680493629 or 680493607; it is best (out of season, otherwise the ticket booth is manned) not to call when you get there, as the cashier takes up to half an hour for the approach. Access and return is possible from 8.30 - 19.00; no access on Mondays. Set the trip odometer to zero at the entrance gate. At 1.2 km, continue down to the right in a right-hand bend, at 2.5 km continue straight ahead at a junction towards the clearly recognizable canyon exit. At 2.6 km you cross a (hopefully open) metal gate, at the next fork go straight on towards the canyon exit. Cross a bridge and continue along the orographic right bank between the (mostly dry) stream and the rock face until shortly before the exit at km 6.5, a large parking area appears on the left behind a tree. Park your car here. A transfer is also possible (see "Parking lot access"), but I cannot recommend it, at best for an alternative entry.		

Approach: (machine translated)

From the parking lot, continue up the slope to the large gravel area above the dam wall, where two streams flow together. The orographic stream on the left is the Rio Verde. Cross the stream above the dam wall, enter the valley of the Rio Verde, cross the Rio Verde immediately afterwards to the right bank and find a wide path that leads upstream. After about 200 m, it crosses the Rio Verde on a suspension bridge, climbs up the opposite bank and then continues horizontally high above the canyon. Passing viewing platforms, the path leads back down to the stream, almost unrecognizably upstream along the left bank, then crosses the stream three more times, twice in fords, continuing up the valley on the right bank. Now the path turns away from the stream and climbs up to the left in a basin. After about 20 minutes, you reach a horizontal, almost completely overgrown track, which you follow to the right. Soon you will see the waterfalls of the Barranco de Funes in front of you and the path descends steadily to the stream. An entry point is possible here.

For a rewarding longer tour, cross the stream and take the wide path on the opposite bank, which flattens out a little after a leftward hairpin bend. Continue upstream on this path, past the striking waterfalls of the Barranco de Funes opposite, until a path branches off to the left. Continue straight ahead on this path until it crosses the now somewhat thinner stream. This is the alternative entry point to the last part of the Barranco Chortal, which then flows into the Rio Verde (Chorreras). It is forbidden to enter the Chortal above this entry point.

Tour: (machine translated)

7 rappels. Beautiful, not very high tufa waterfalls. Several possible jumps, some "delicate" slides. At the first suspension bridge seen from the access, jumps of 7-14 m into a deep pool are possible. The 14 m jump is located to the right of the orographic path leading up to the left.

Return: (machine translated)

After the narrow 12 m waterfall, you can see the path on which we climbed the side valley to the slope during the access. After a few pools return to the access path or continue in the streambed to the first suspension bridge seen from below. Here from the streambed to the right up on the path.
