Short vertical descent down to Lake Garda.

On the SS45bis coming from the north (Riva del Garda), pass through Limone and after the long road tunnel, turn right up the impressive road to Pieve (Tremosine). It pays to drive the entire road from the upper parking lot through the Brasa canyon. At night this road gorge part is impressively illuminated. It is a must to see. Both restaurants in the canyons are highly recommended. In Pieve itself, it is worth to enjoy the great view above Lake Garda ("Shudder Terrace"). The road is very narrow and parking is not always possible. The lower parking lot (P2) is on the shoulder of the first rightward haipin bend of the SP38 road up to Tremosine. The upper parking lot (P1) just before the bridge at the entry on the right or a few meters further up on the left.

Approach: (machine translated)

Enter the stream at the indicated parking coordinates (P1).

Tour: (machine translated)

The descent begins from the road bridge immediately times very vertically. 7 rappelling points, the upper in the water jet. Nasty smell at the exit.

Return: (machine translated)

Do NOT climb up to the main road at the exit. You would have to hike through two long tunnels, which would be very dangerous on this road. It is better to swim to the right along the shore for a few hundred meters until you can climb up to the old harbour road after the tunnel section. You will soon reach the junction at the main road that leads to the lower parking lot (P2). Distance between the two parking lots: 2.3km
