<b>Gear:</b>		
<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Beautiful limestone gorge structured in several levels, with open and closed sections and without great difficulties, only 3 rappels at the beginning and then pools in which to cool off. It usually has water all year round thanks to a couple of springs.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We must be located in La Pobla de Segur by the N260 or by the C13. Here we will turn off towards Claverol and Aramunt, cross the Noguera Pallaresa, leave a detour to the left and continue towards Aramunt/Pessonada until we find the detour to the left to Pessonada/Sant Martí de Canals. We will follow this road for 6kms until Pessonada.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the village, once the road ends, we will continue along the track for half an hour until we reach a sharp left curve with an alameda in the background, from here we will go down to the river just towards the spring.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Nice gorge that begins with 3 small rappels and then closes in high walls through which we will walk passing overhangs and pools to a small dam. The ravine opens up (we can escape to the right through the meadows) to give way to the next gorge where we will continue to a 4m drop where we will exit through the rocky area on the right.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) The exit through the rocky area is not easy, there are marks to overcome this barrier but it is quite unpleasant to go up it. At the top we will see a track that we will take to the right (east) and then to the left (north direction) and that will turn to the NW to take us to the village on the south side of this one.
