Access: (machine translated) See photo gallery: approach from Rome, Frosinone, Cassino and shuttle P2 (exit) - P1 (access)		
Approach: (machine translated) From the P1 parking lot, continue south along the road. Take the next path on the right - "Sentiero WWF" - and turn right again at the fork. You then have the option of making a short detour to the north to a viewpoint near a small house. Return and continue on the "Sentiero WWF" until it crosses the streambed (entry). * http://www.canyoning.it/images/logopdfnid.gif See also photo gallery: Access It may be possible to start earlier via a dry side gorge, see http://caracal.duckeater.fr/?can=93		
Tour: (machine translated) First in the open streambed to the beginning of the gorge. Then follow several rappels (first some smaller ones, then 27, 38, 7, 26, 7) until the Gole del Quirino flows in from the left. Before the dam wall, where a foul-smelling tributary comes from the right, exit to the right. It would be possible to continue below the dam wall, under the road bridge, to the exit of the gorge and then exit to the right.
