Summary: (machine translated)

In the upper part impressively narrow canyon in white, massively banked limestone with some nice slides and jumps. The lower part is more open and less attractive

Hydrology:

Takes water from subterranean reservoirs. Ideal in Spring or after rain.

Access: (machine translated)

A28 until the Fontanafredda exit, from here follow the signs for Aviano. After passing the US military base, go straight towards Budoia. Cross the village of Dardago and follow the road into the valley of Torrente Cunaz. Park at the second inn.

Approach: (machine translated)

Follow the asphalt road for a short while, then turn right onto the marked trail 990a, soon after turn right again onto trail 994. This trail shortens several hairpin bends of the old road. When you see the narrow gorge of Torrente Cunaz below you, climb briefly before descending on a clear path to the streambed that you reach just above the gorge.

Tour: (machine translated)

After a series of slides you are in front of the first abseil.\n * 6m from anchor left\n * 14m from anchor left\n * 7m from anchor left\n * 6m slide -. can also be repeated via an adventurous rope ladder/railing construction\n * 18m rappel across a suspended pool from anchor left (you can also jump or slide into the first pool)\n * 18m from anchor right\n * 10m from anchor right\n * 4m jump/slide\n * 7m rappel from anchor left with chain\n * 25m rappel from 2 anchors right\n beautiful rock basin\nFrom here the canyon is more open - downclimbs and short slides/jumps alternate, a 12m rappel.\nThe tour ends above a weir.

Super nice canyon. Defenetly worth it, also the lower more open part is nice. Maybe there are some anchors missing, but you can downclimb but it would be nice to have them.

Beautiful white limestone, nice atmosphere, though only 4 stars for the upper part with good water. Overall suprisingly well bolted, for high flow also ok, only one location obviously is a conflictive area with many damaged/missing anchors - newly drilled one M10 on the left bank, somewhat higher than the original lines (one damaged anchor right bank, or chock stones could also be usable in case of emergency).
