Unmissable descent of the Pasiego valleys, where we will descend the Cascada Aguasal or churrón de Agualto of 55 meters.

To combine with the ferrata and any of the other descents of Pandillo.

Access to Vega de Pas area

We must arrive to Vega de Pas. From the N623 in Entrambasmestas we will take the CA263.

When arriving at Vega de Pas we will turn off by the CA630 to Pandillo.

Aguasal, La Coteruela, La Capia and Ruyemas ravines.

We will park in the village

Accesses Aguasal, La Coteruela, La Capia and Ruyemas

We start with a series of ledges until we reach the first mandatory rappel, from there we have a succession of rappels until we reach the great Aguasal waterfall where we will find the meeting point on the left. At the base of the waterfall we will have the next rappel to which we will have to access through a handrail. Then we enter an embedded area where we will find two more rappels. Once we leave this area the ravine opens up where we will have some more rappel or avoid them on the sides until we reach the end of the ravine, this being the conjunction of the Aguasal, Alisuca and Monte Colina rivers.

From the end of the ravine we continue downstream, on the right bank we climb a few meters and access the upstream path that we have used.
