Summary: (machine translated) Relatively short forest canyon that can be walked when other canyons have too much water.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Coming from Bern we leave the A6 via exit 17 - Thun Süd. First we go through Almendingen, then via Amsoldingen and Höfen to Oberstockach. Continue in the direction of Niederstockach. 700m after the 90 degree bend in Oberstockach we turn right onto Almendstrasse and pass the Bruni firewood sawmill. 400m after the turn off from the main road we turn left at the junction and after another 350m we meet directly "our" brook. Here we park our car at a suitable place. If there are problems with this parking place or the access here, we can park our car in Niederstockach at the Gasthof zum Stockhorn - "P alternatively" - and then walk here first.		
Approach: (machine translated) From parking lot P (at the Feissibach) we take the slope along the stream upwards. It ends in the streambed below the final waterfalls. Further on, a path leads steeply up in serpentine. It joins a trail coming from the right and now goes directly towards the creek and the canyon. There (about 100 meters after this crossroads), where it makes a hairpin bend to the right (840m altitude), we leave the path and climb directly about 30m up the canyon rim (orange markings on the trees). We come to a tree adorned with a cross in orange. From here we rope into the canyon (about 15m) - "E2".		
Tour: (machine translated) Barely interrupted sequence of waterfalls in beautifully washed out rock, a total of about 10 rappels, several of them over 2 steps.		
Return: (machine translated) After the final waterfall turn left out onto the dirt road and in a few minutes back to the car.
