Summary: (machine translated) Very interesting dry canyon after rains. Avoid the summer.canyon with very long and hard approach,a lot of vegetation.we will have to make rappels of fortune from trees.everything will take us at least 7 or 8 hours,an adventure for the bravest.you could say that it is for collectors.foresee pruning shears and long pants.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) We will have to go to La Sénia by the CV105 towards Fredes, when crossing the bridge of the reservoir of Ulldecona, we will see a track on the right by which we will go up with the car. After passing the tail of the reservoir we will have a fork, on the right the Bco de Fou, we will continue on the left. 1,5 kms later another fork at the exit of the Bco de Presseguer. We park here.		
Approach: (machine translated) We will leave by the track by which we accessed and after a kilometer and a half the track crosses to the other side, 500m later we will have a path on the right that goes up to the Mas del Paraire through the cliffs. Once in the Mas we take the track to the Tosal de Cervera and a path to the right puts us on the ridge of the mountain, which we will follow until we take another track that goes along the ridge (the views are breathtaking) to the Pico Montenegrolo. Before reaching it we will see the ravine on our right. We will have to go down without obvious path through goat trails.another option is to climb the top, to go through a kind of open hill, to look for the bed of the ravine.cross-country the last stretch, although it is shorter than the first option, and the views are well worth it.		
Tour: (machine translated) Dry ravine that after rains has a couple of spectacular waterfalls.		
Return: (machine translated) We will find a track that goes up on the orographic right of the bank, we will follow it up to the confluence with the track where we parked.

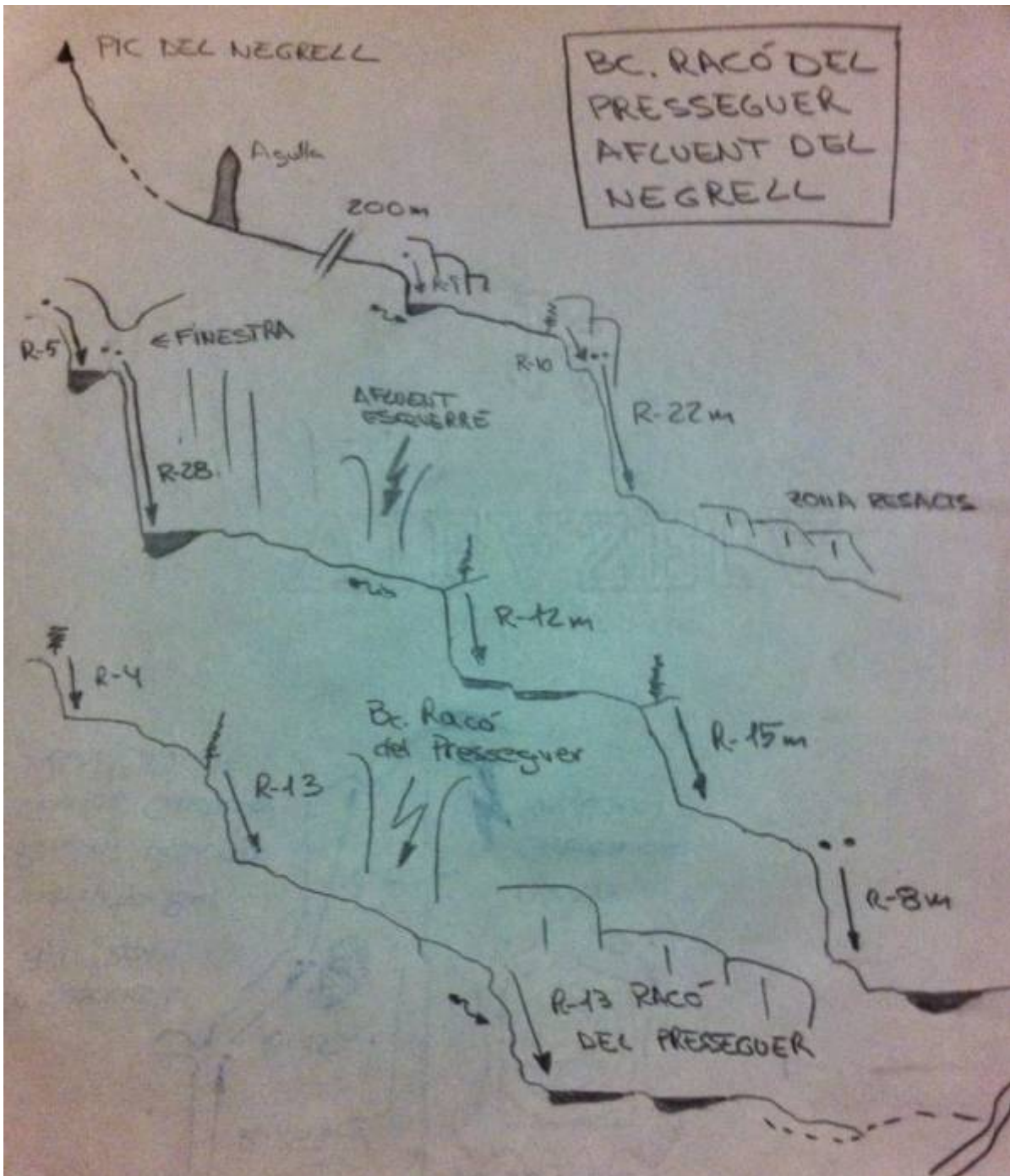
