Summary: (machine translated) Worthwhile short and narrow canyon; very watery (be sure to check the water level!!!); most of the rappels are in the water course; loud noise level; little light; many slippery spots.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Torbole drive to Riva del Garda. Here take the bypass north (ri. Brescia). Turn right into Via Ardarò. 1Km through the village of San Giacomo. At the small church and bridge you will find a small parking (110Hm) (if you have no parking here you can park about 100m in town).		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot up past the yellow big house (asphalt road with driving ban) you come to a small bridge, here you can take a look into the stream --> then it goes up on the stepped hiking trail (Deva, Foci, Maddalena) --> over a fixed rope and attached ladder you come to a red hiking marker and lattice mast --> here it actually goes left. However, if you go straight, you can check the actual water level at the exit of the canyons --> after checking, go back and continue up the trail. After the stone slabs and with trail markers it becomes flatter. The path leads into the forest and to the stream (entry). Here on the left comes a small tributary with a bridge into the stream.		
Tour: (machine translated) Before starting the tour, the weather and the water level should always be carefully checked because the canyon becomes very dangerous at high water levels. At the beginning of the tour comes a short walking passage with small steps that are bypassed or rappel. After a short distance the canyon narrows. Here comes the first dangerous place (abseiling with a backflow in the pool in the middle). With a little skill, one ropes past the pool on the right. Behind the edge below the belaystation there is the possibility to install a redirection. (possibly system setup for the last). Narrowly cut with little incidence of light, it continues to the next 2 small rappelling points and a climbing and walking passage (however, artificial light can be dispensed with). This is followed by several abseils between 10-20m which are partly in the water flow. After the last 20m step, the route continues over several boulders into open terrain. Shortly you reach a small path on the right (exit).		
Return: (machine translated) Even before the inflow from the left, the trail goes out of the canyons on the right. Follow the path that shortly meets the access path. Then continue back to the parking lot.

The flow today was higher than usual after a few days of rain (we had 0,10

I wouldn't say the descent is a5 but it isn't harmless either: there's undercurrents, some slippery spots and the occasional rock hiding in the white water. Unfortunately rather short. The damaged handline refers to a steel cable, gloves come recommended. The anchors aging, but they do the job.

We did it yesterday at 24.9 with lots of water. There aren't any particular problems because the last 3 rappels can also be done outside the flow. The normal level is about 0.060m (6cm), we covered it with 0.13m and if you are not familiar with the gorge, the descents in the flow are not trivial.
