Summary: (machine translated)

If you love high abseils, you've come to the right place. It's almost 60m down into the Jungle's Exit in one go. Otherwise a rather short canyon that makes sense in combination with the Kobelache (KanguruJumpingCanyon).

Access: (machine translated)

Freeway exit Dornbirn Süd and then continue in the direction of Gütle. It is best to leave a bike (or second car) at the inn in Gütle and continue by car in the direction of Ebnit. Cross the Rappenlochschlucht gorge over a bridge and after another 650m a road branches off to the left uphill. Follow this road until you reach a saddle where you can park.

Approach: (machine translated)

Follow the road for about 80m until a forest road branches off to the left, which you follow for about 2km until you reach a bridge.

Tour: (machine translated)

First descend before the bridge, orographically to the left of the stream, on a small path. Climbing over a few rocks, you reach the first rappel. Another small rappel follows, then the high waterfall. This beautiful rappel, which hangs freely for about 40m, is conquered in one go. First follow the stream, but then you can also use a narrow path on the left in the forest. After approx. 300m you come to an old bridge pillar where you descend into the stream again. After another 50 m, you will see a ladder (2021) and climbing tracks on the right that lead to a path.

Return: (machine translated)

Follow the path for 250m until you reach a crossroads. If you take the path to the left, you come to the Kobelache (KanguruJumpingCanyon). If you want to finish the tour, follow the other path, which later turns into a road back to Gütle. The most fit can now cycle up the steepest public road in Vorarlberg and pick up the car from the parking lot. (around 30 minutes depending on your motivation)
