O salto del Guanche, is a spectacular dry canyon very vertical, with long verticals and almost without rest. Terrain for people with experience.

We must be located in Güímar

With the return vehicle we follow the TF28 until the p.k. 27.5 where the road to Barranco Badajoz leaves to our right (southbound). It is normal to park at the kilometer marker, at the turnoff to the road to Zarzales. Although we can try to park further on

We will continue along the TF28 until almost the p.k. 30 to turn off to the right onto the track that takes us up to the windows of Güímar by the track of Anochezca. Very famous and somewhat dangerous path through the channel in which we will have to go through its tunnels.

Through the channel of the windows of Güímar, after the 6th tunnel we go out through the water channel to the riverbed, the first installation is on the ground.
