After crossing the stream (start of inferiore part), follow path 641.
The path initially corresponds exactly to the track on OSM, but later it gets lost. 2021 the path was marked with blue dots. You reach path 621.
Turn left and follow the path for about 1050m to reach the streambed

We descended the upper and lower parts of the canyon. At the access, despite the blue dots, attention is needed in some places, as animal tracks can mislead us and take up time. Overall, the access is not very problematic. Took 1:40h. The anchorages in the gorge are fine. In the lower part of the Pliza, a nut was missing on the 70m waterfall at the intermediate anchorage. It is OK now. It took us just under 4 hours to descend the upper and lower canyon. (machine translated)
