Summary: (machine translated) Moderately rewarding canyon with little water		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Coming from Austria via A23 until Pontebba. Leave the highway at Pontebba and continue on the SS13 canal road. After the village of Resiutta, just before reaching Moggio, park in a small parking lot on the right side of the road.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking place walk for about 700m along the main road until you reach a gravel parking place on the left side of the road where the hiking trail 743a starts. Follow the trail uphill for about an hour until you approach the stream and you can easily get on at a bridge. If necessary, take a second car to Stavoli Ravorade, see Rio Chiampeit option 2.		
Tour: (machine translated) The tour begins immediately with the highest, mostly dry Cascade (25m). As an anchor point, take the tree orographic right (60m rope advantageous). After some block hopping follows the next break. The anchor is again a tree, from which it is not easy to pull the ropes. Another 4m rappel brings us to a small pool from where it goes about 15m in a light water stream into the depths. After a short hike the streambed widens and you come to an isolated "Hinkelstein" on whose right side a dry rappel from one of the trees is possible! More beautiful, however, is the rappel orogr. further to the right in the watercourse. For this, however, a rappelling stand must be drilled in. Artificial rappelling points one looks (spring 2013) in this canyon in vain. A rappel over tree trunks, however, is always possible - even if sometimes somewhat cumbersome! Massive rock in the upper part, Bröckel conglomerate in the lower part, escape possibility in higher positions always given.		
Return: (machine translated) After the last rappel you can see the Kanaltalstraße in front of you and in 5 minutes you are at the car parked before.
