Summary: (machine translated) Simple canyon to combine with Sajolida, basically it is just a different and somewhat dressed way to do the second part of Sajolida (see review to continue descent). Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) We must be located in Collbató in the middle of Montserrat. Situation bcos Sajolida, Bugaders and Pont Once in the village we will look for the signs to get to the restaurant Vinya Nova where we will park.		
Approach: (machine translated) Accesses to Sajolida, Bugaders and Pont banks We leave by the track on the right towards the Torrent del Pont, which we will go up by its fixed ropes or we leave to the right by a path that goes up to a hill where we find a cairn and red paint marks (next to the Roca Mala). Follow the markers and cairns to the Clot de Sajolida. We will follow the path to climb the next ridge, from here we can already see the Bugaders riverbed.		
Tour: (machine translated) Simple, only 4 rappels to reach the confluence with Sajolida.		
Return: (machine translated) We must continue through Sajolida or look for the exit to Roca Mala and from here to the pass and undo the access path.
