Summary: (machine translated) Alpine canyon, south-facing, little cut, sequence of waterfalls without runs, no possible jumps, rarely a possibility for slides, short, pleasant access		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Chateau d'Oex in the Saane valley (975m above sea level), take the Route du Mont, then keep left at the last houses onto the Route du Clôt and drive up the northern slope above the village in long serpentines to the exit of the road at the hamlet of Les Planards (1325m above sea level). - Ask for permission to park.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the farm, we climb up the meadow in a westerly direction on indistinct tracks and enter the forest at a metal fence crossing. We follow the now clear path (red and white markings), cross a steep mountain flank sloping down to the canyon and then stand in the streambed. If you also want to walk the upper part of the Tenasses, follow the stream up the other bank, cross a side ditch, then keep sharp right and follow the path to the Tenasses at 1500m.		
Tour: (machine translated) Descent in mostly open streambed on grippy limestone in small-scale steps. Practically no running sections.		
Return: (machine translated) As soon as you meet red rock in the streambed, look for a suitable exit that leads us pathless and steeply up to the farm where our car is parked.

The canyon is still largely buried under avalanche snow. The steps of the first 3-4 cascades can already be rappelled if you crawl under the ice after the rappel or continue rappelling on the ice to the next belay. We got off after the big step as all the anchors and the entire canyon are buried under the avalanche snow. The exit is difficult, tricky and laborious. Current ascents only recommended with ice equipment and/or a drill (machine translated)
