<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) O de las Lastras Marinas is a nice descent at the foot of Calar del Mundo. Except for heavy rains, the stream will not put any problem to your descent. Prohibited from March to May. <b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Getting to Yeste Take the AB512 to the Tus Spa. When we get there we will leave it behind to go to Collado Tornero, shortly before arriving we will find the parking lot. If we have two cars, with the access car we go back to the crossroads and go up to Giles. At the entrance to Giles we have the detour to the left to Las Lagunicas. We will pass it and we will arrive at Tinada de Mancheños where there is a crossing with a light post that we take to the left, this small road goes down to the river. We park. There is also the option of parking.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From Tinada, the access to the river is direct, we will have to follow the river for about 1000m until the real beginning of the descent. From Lagunillas leaves a track that takes us almost to the beginning of the river. From the parking lot below the Collado Tornero there is a marked path that takes us right to the headwaters, you can't miss it.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Beautiful and quite steep descent, some slides and a couple of jumps along with 8 rappels in a quite leafy descent.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) We will arrive at the Tus river, on the right bank we will find a path to go to the road and from there to the parking lot.

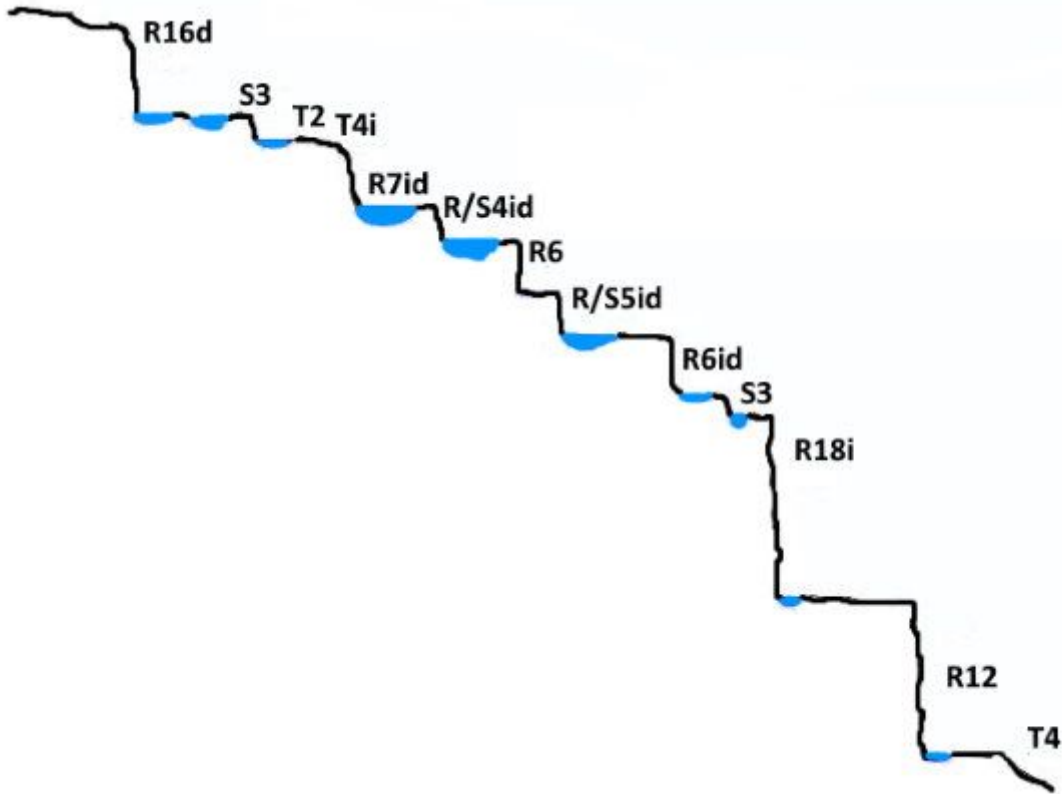
